

4 DAYS DANANG – HOIAN CLASSIC 4Days 3Nights

DAY 1: Arrival – Danang – Hoian (D)

Upon arrival at Danang International Airport, you are greeted and driven to Hoian, which was originally a Cham seaport but has been influenced down centuries by a myriad of traders from various cultures. Dinner at local restaurant. Overnight in Hoian.

DAY 2: Hoian – Bana Hill – Walking Tour – Hoian (B,L,D)



After breakfast, transfer to Bana Hill Station and take about 1.30hours. You have a chance to ride on a modern system of cable cars helps you get a bird's-eye view, very miraculous and attractive while enjoying a feeling of flying in the blue sky amidst the clouds and wind. Thereafter, visit some old French villas en route, as well as the suspension bridge, Nui Chua & the Mountain Peak (at the height of 1,487m), Vong Nguyet villa where we will visit the wine cellar, Linh Ung Pagoda. Our Final stop is at Orchid garden before come back to the station by cable cars. We drive back to Hoian town afterward. In the afternoon, we enjoy a half day walking tour through the narrow winding streets of the Ancient Quarter, visiting Chua Ong Pagoda, Chinese Assembly Halls, the 200-year old Tam Ky house and the Japanese Covered Bridge. Overnight in Hoian



DAY 3: Hoian – Danang (B,L,D)

After breakfast, we start the day with the drive to Danang City where we will visit the Marble Mountains. The five 'mountains' are named after the five elements: Kim (Metal), Thuy (Water), Moc (Wood), Hoa (Fire) and Tho (Earth). Several Buddhist sanctuaries can also be found within the mountains, making this a famous tourist destination. Thereafter, visit Cham Museum. The Cham Museum's first building was opened in 1919, but



many Cham sculptures collected in Danang, Quang Nam and elsewhere were brought to the site over the preceding twenty years. The collection was begun by French archaeologists and experts from L' Ecole Francaise d' Extreme Orient (EFEO). Some artefacts were sent to Paris and others to the Hanoi and Saigon (Ho Chi Minh City) museums, but many typical objects were left in Danang. Next, proceed to Danang Market, which sells a wide array of local goods and handicrafts. Overnight in Danang.

DAY 4: Danang – Departure (B)

After breakfast, free at leisure till transfer to the airport for your flight back.
