

## EDUCATIONAL TRIP IN HOCHIMINH CITY

### 5days4nights

#### Day 1 Hochiminh Arrival (D)

Upon arrival at Tan Son Nhat International Airport, meet the tour guide then transfer to local restaurant for dinner. After dinner, transfer to hotel check in.

#### Day 2: Full Day School Visit (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel and depart to local school. Cultural Exchange with local students through observation and recognition of local customs or do some minor repair if any. Having lunch and dinner at local restaurant then back hotel



#### Day 3: Traditional Vietnamese Cooking – Historic Trip to Cu Chi Tunnels – War Museum (B, L, D)



Breakfast at hotel and depart for Agricultural Villages where student have an opportunity to explore traditional Agriculture in Vietnam through activities such as Farm visiting and Cultural Experience Traditional Vietnamese cooking with natural ingredients from the garden. Having lunch at local restaurant. Visit Cu Chi Tunnels after through beautiful landscape of countryside. Before entering the tunnels, you'll see a short introductory video about what life was like for soldiers who lived there during the war. Spend the next hour exploring

the tunnel maze. Also on display are various man traps, the remains of an American tank, and numerous bomb craters created by 500-pound bombs dropped by B52 bombers. Visit War Remnants Museum with many exhibits of the Wars in Vietnam – from the French times of the American ones. Having dinner before back to hotel

#### Day 4: Cultural Trip – Mekong Delta (My Tho) (B, L, D)

Leave hotel for cultural trip to visit: Re-unification Palace built in 1869 on the site of the former presidential palace of the French Governor of Indochina and The Notre Dame Cathedral (outside visit due to renovation) and the Central Post Office built between 1877 and 1883 by renowned designer Gustav Eiffel. The cathedral remains an active church with services each day and is favored backdrop for Vietnamese wedding photographs. Then proceed to My Tho city belongs to Mekong Delta. Board a wooden motorboat to Unicorn Island. On this boat along the river's bank, you will be passing through natural creeks and quiet villages and watch rural people going to work. You will see an interesting fishermen's port, stilt houses. One of the boat's stops during this trip is at a large orchard that has many different types of tasty tropical fruits for your enjoyments. After having lunch, visit Turtle Island. Here, on a small rowboat, you'll see

interesting transportation modes that local people use to move around. From there, we'll take you to a bee farm where you have a chance to taste a tasteful cup of authentic honey tea while checking out the folk music that is typical to only the people in Southern Vietnam. After that we'll take you to a village where you can smell the flavor of coconut candies being made many yards away. This is a great chance to witness how village people make candy and handcrafted items from coconuts. You might learn that those people can amazingly make dozens of useful products out of coconut trees.  
Return Hochiminh city and enjoy dinner

After breakfast at hotel, transfer to the airport for departure flight back home destination.
