

PILGRIMAGE VIETNAM

9Days 8Nights

DAY 01: Arrival – Ha Long (B,D)

You are met at Noi Bai Airport and escorted to Halong Bay – The World Heritage (more than 200km from No Bai airport). Check in hotel for freshen- up and relaxation. Overnight in Ha Long.

DAY 02: Ha Long – Ha Noi (B,L)

After breakfast at hotel, you will get on boat for cruising around the islets, caves and grottos of Halong Bay. The boat will stop a while for you to take a short excursion visit Sung Sot ('The Cave of Surprise') grotto. Enjoy seafood lunch on board before leaving Halong for Hanoi.

Upon arrive Hanoi, we roaming to the old streets for one hour looking & shopping. 17:00 gather at Thang Long Theatre near Hoan Kiem Lake for enjoying the Water puppets show.

Overnight in Ha Noi.

DAY 03: Ha Noi – Saint Joseph's Cathedral (B,L)



Today we will take a city tour including Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (Mondays and Fridays closed), His House on Stilt, Van Mieu – the first university of Vietnam. Especialy, Saint Joseph's Cathedral. Saint Joseph Cathedral is a Roman Catholic cathedral in Hanoi, Vietnam. It is the seat of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Hanoi. The church was built in 1886 in the neo-gothic style. It holds several masses throughout the day and is usually crowded on weekends and religious holidays. Have

lunch in the local restaurant. Then you have free time to explore Ha Noi by your way.

Overnight in Ha Noi

DAY 04: Ha Noi – Da Nang – Hoi An (B,L)

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to the airport for the short flight to Da Nang. Welcome by our Tour Guide at the airport in Danang, then transfer to Hoi An.

Today, we have a walking tour in Hoi An Old Quarter. The ancient architecture of Hoi An is a fascinating combination of Vietnamese traditional characters with Chinese and Japanese influence. There are plenty to see in this delightful and tranquil town, some of which are the famous Japanese Covered Bridges, the Pottery Museum, the 200 years old Tam Ky House, the vibrant market. We visit these on our morning walking tour past many low tiled houses scattered along the small streets and assembly halls which reflect the town's multi-cultural past. Enjoy lunch at charming restaurant. Then check-in the hotel. Take a boat trip on Thu Bon river for sightseeing and relax. Discovery night in Hoian.

Overnight in Hoi An

DAY 05: Hoi An – Da Nang – Da Nang Cathedral – Hue (B,L)

After breakfast, we drive to Da Nang. Arrive in Da Nang, then transfer to visit Marble Mountain. Have lunch in local restaurant then check in the hotel. Afternoon we will visit Da Nang Cathedral - known to locals as Con Ga Church (Rooster Church) because of the weathercock on top of the steeple, the candy-pink Danang Cathedral (Tran Phu street) was built for the city's French residents in 1923. The cathedral still functions as a lively place of worship; in fact late-comers for services often find all the seats are taken. Then you are free to explore Da Nang.

DAY 06: Da Nang – Hue – La Vang Holy Land – Phong Nha – Hue (B,L)



Early breakfast at the hotel. Then transfer to airport for a flight to Hue. Arrive in Hue. Check in for the hotel then we depart for Quang Binh. To Phong Nha, your boat down the river to visit Phong Nha Cave (the largest cave in the world which is recognized by UNESCO is a world natural heritage with Hang Bi Ky, Tien ...). Have lunch at the local restaurant. On the way back to Hue, visiting the La Vang Holy Land- State basilica. La Vang Holy is a shrine located in Hai Lang

district, Quang Tri Province. Christians believe that Mary shows flexibility in this area in 1798 and a church was erected near the three-banyan tree, where the apparitions, and this is an important place of pilgrimage of Catholics Vietnam. La Vang Holy was awarded by Vatican Holy is the Emirate Palace of La Vang Cathedral from 1961. Free at night. Overnight in Hue

DAY 07: Hue – Sai Gon (B,L)

After breakfast, take a sight seeing tour to visit the Imperial Citadel from where the Nguyen dynasty ruled between 1802 and 1945. Have lunch at local restaurant then check out the hotel and transfer to the airport to take a flight to Sai Gon. Arrive in Sai Gon and have free time.

Overnight in Sai Gon.

DAY 08: Sai Gon – Cu Chi - Notre Dame Cathedral (B,L)

After breakfast, we drive to visit the Cuchi Tunnels. At the height of the Vietnam war, the tunnel system stretched from the outskirts of Saigon all the way to the Cambodian border of over 250 kilometers of tunnels. The tunnel system, built over 25 years starting in the 1940s, let the Viet Minh and, later, the Viet Cong, control a huge rural area. Have lunch at local restaurant. Afternoon, we will take in the former Presidential Palace, Old Saigon



Post Office, History Museum and the Notre Dame Cathedral – another name is Saigon Notre-Dame Basilica. This is an officially Basilica of Our Lady of The Immaculate Conception located in the downtown of Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam. Established by French colonists, the cathedral was constructed between 1863 and 1880. It has two bell towers, reaching a height of 58 meters (190 feet). Overnight in Sai Gon.

DAY 09: Sai Gon – Departure (B)

Leisure before check-out. Transfer to the airport for departure.
